This course allows you to brush up on your written and spoken English. <b>You must attend for an assessment before you start the course.</b> These courses are free.	

<b>What will I learn on this course?</b>
You will be invited along to an initial assessment to find out what you need to work on and agree your learning aims. For example, you may need to: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Work on writing your name and address</li> <li>• Join in discussions</li> <li>• Learn where to use full stops and capital letters</li> <li>• Write in sentences</li> <li>• Use joining words correctly</li> </ul>

<b>Assessment</b>	<b>Awarding body: City and Guilds</b>
The aim of this course is to improve your basic English skills. They are assessed using assignment tasks.	

<b>Course Length</b>
You may need just a few weeks of practice or up to 72 hours of tuition – it's all free.

<b>Attendance</b>
In order that you will be able to successfully complete your qualification it is essential that you attend 90% of the taught sessions, so please think carefully before enrolling on this course if you have work or other commitments that may interfere with your attendance.

<b>What else do I need to know?</b>
You can begin at any point in the year and you will work towards the following qualifications: Entry Level 1 or 2 – laying the groundwork and brushing up on the basics.

<b>What could I do next?</b>
You could move up to the next level in English or onto a maths course.



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
