<b>What will I learn on this course?</b>
You will develop your ability to form your own sentences. The course will cover topics such as: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Talking about leisure activities, likes and dislikes</li> <li>• Discussing future plans and past holidays</li> <li>• Learning about Germany, its regions and cities</li> <li>• Giving opinions and making comparisons.</li> </ul> <p>You will have lots of opportunities for practising speaking and listening through role-play, pair and group work.</p>
