What will I learn on this course?

This course is for individuals who want to learn how to do very basic PC repairs gaining greater control over your computer. You will cover:

- How to diagnose simple computer faults (hardware and software)
- How to carry out simple upgrades
- How to keep your computer secure
- How to defend your machine against worms and malware
- How to recognise computer components and buy with confidence
- How to manage and configure Windows (and other operating systems).
