No prior knowledge is required to attend this one day course on Food Safety Level 2, aimed at food handlers.

## What will I learn on this course?

This course provides an introduction to food safety and will benefit anyone working in a situation where food is prepared, cooked and served. There are eight key areas:

- The Law
- Food safety hazards
- Refrigeration, chilling and cold holding of food
- Food handling
- Principles of safe food storage
- Cleaning
- Food premises and equipment

The course book is included in the fee.

## Assessment

## Awarding body: Highfields

Short multiple choice exam consisting of 20 questions, must be taken at the end of the course. Pass rate is over 12 correct answers.

## Course Length

1 day course, 9am – 6pm.

## Attendance

All day attendance is necessary.

## What else do I need to know?

This course will give you a Level 2 Food Safety qualification that will be validated for 3 years. This is essential if you wish to work in hospitality or catering, or catering services.

## What could I do next?

City and Guilds Level 1 Hospitality and Catering Course for 6 weeks, including 3 weeks work placement as a catering assistant at the YMCA Café and Kitchen.
