# Course Information for Languages and Literature

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# British Sign Language Introduction

## Enrolment Requirements

This course is for anyone who wishes to learn some basic techniques of British Sign Language. You do not need any previous experience of British Sign Language to start this class, it will introduce you to techniques used to help you decide if you would like to progress to an accredited course.

## What will I learn on this course?

The BSL introduction course will include the following topics:

- An introduction to deaf awareness
- Finger spelling names and places
- Meeting and greeting others
- Numbers, travel and directions
- Describing and asking about the weather
- Describing people, animals and objects around the home
- Time, dates and money
- Activities and interests, food and drink.

The course will be very practical and you will be given lots of opportunities to practice in pairs and small groups.

Your tutor is a BSL user and your first session will be supported by a BSL interpreter.

## Assessment

**Awarding body:** N/A

Activities and work will be assessed by your tutor.

## Course Length

5 weeks.

## Attendance

You will be expected to attend every week.  
If you cannot attend you will be set work to ensure you meet your learning outcomes.

**What else do I need to know?**

You do not need to do any written work at home. However, practising between sessions will help you to reinforce signs and can be fun to do with family and friends, just as you would if you were learning a foreign language.

**What could I do next?**

This is not an accredited course but may encourage you to progress to the Level 1 in BSL.



# British Sign Language Level 1

This course is for anyone who wishes to communicate with deaf people on a range of topics using simple, everyday language. You may have completed an Introduction to British Sign Language course. You do not need to have any knowledge of the subject. You should not be taking any other accredited qualifications whilst completing this course as the commitment is considerable.

## What will I learn on this course?

The BSL Level 1 course is divided into three units covering these topics:

### Unit 101

- Finger spelling names and places
- Meeting and greeting others
- Numbers, travel and directions
- Describing and asking about the weather

### Unit 102

- Describing people, animals and objects around the home
- Time, date and money
- Activities and interests, food and drink

### Unit 103

- Everyday life relating to work, school and college.

The course will be very practical and you will be given lots of opportunities to practice. Your tutor is a BSL user.

## Assessment

## Awarding body: Signatures

You will have three externally set assessments. They will be short conversations with your tutor which will be recorded on video. Your tutor will assess the first with the other two being assessed externally.

**The cost of the three assessments are included in your course fee.**

A small video camera will be used at various points during the course to record your progress. Your tutor will use the recordings to guide you on how to improve.

**Course Length**

This is a 30 week course and it is vital that you attend sessions.

**Attendance**

It is a requirement that you attend 90% of the taught sessions to ensure you have the best chance of achieving the accreditation. Please think carefully before enrolling on this course if you have work commitments that may interfere with this attendance.

**What else do I need to know?**

There will be an opportunity to purchase a DVD to help with your studies, you will also be asked to purchase a BSL dictionary. You will also be required to practice your skills at home with family and friends and also carry out homework tasks as part of the course.

# German Beginners

## Term 1, 2 & 3

This course is for absolute beginners. The emphasis will be on speaking and using the language. Writing tasks will be available for those who find this helpful.

### What will I learn on this course?

Over a period of three terms, you will learn and use simple words and phrases to be able to get by in everyday situations abroad.

The course will cover the following topics:

- Introducing self and family/friends/colleagues
- Numbers and colours
- Ordering food and drink and paying
- Booking accommodation
- Asking for and giving directions
- Shopping for food, clothes and important holiday items
- Dealing with transport
- Additional topics by student request or need.

Lessons will be built around a course book for you to refer to back at home. New language will be presented with colourful pictures on the interactive whiteboard. You will have plenty of opportunities for practising speaking and listening through role-play, pair work, CDs etc. A choice of tasks will be given (from easy to more challenging), so that there will be suitable activities for all abilities. You will also be able to submit additional work and have this handed back with correction advice and feedback.

### Assessment

Activities and work will be assessed by your tutor.

### Course Length

10 weeks in the autumn and spring term together with a shorter course in the summer.

### Attendance

You will be expected to attend every week. If you cannot attend, you will be set work to ensure you meet your learning outcomes.

You will be given work to do at home and, to get the most out of your course, you will need to practise regularly – 10 or 15 minutes each day is best. You will also have opportunity to submit individual additional work to your tutor and have it corrected.

# German Improvers

This course is for those who **already have some knowledge** of the language (approximately equal to 1 year of learning). The emphasis will be on speaking and using the language with some grammar.

### What will I learn on this course?

This course will revise and build on what students have already learnt and will introduce new topics, according to student needs.

The topics covered will include:

- revision and extension of talking and writing about self and others, directions, restaurant, shopping, times, booking accommodation
- dealing with transport
- daily activities
- talking and writing about what you did
- talking and writing about what you are going to do
- arranging and negotiating activities with friends, family, work colleagues
- additional topics to be negotiated once course has started.

Lessons will be built around a course book for you to refer to back at home. New language will be presented with colourful pictures on the interactive whiteboard. You will have plenty of opportunities for practising speaking and listening through role-play, pair work, CDs etc. You will be given a choice of tasks at different levels to suit your learning needs. You will also be able to submit additional work and have this handed back with correction advice and feedback.

### Assessment

**Awarding body: N/A**

You will be given work to do at home and, to get the most out of your course, you will need to practise regularly – 10 or 15 minutes each day is best. You will have opportunity to submit both this and individual additional optional work to your tutor and have it corrected.

### Course Length

10 weeks in the autumn and spring term together with a shorter course in the summer.

### Attendance

You will be expected to attend every week. If you cannot attend, you will be set work to ensure you meet your learning outcomes.

**What else do I need to know?**
